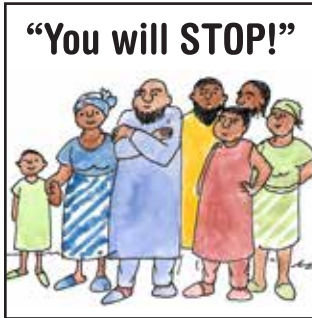

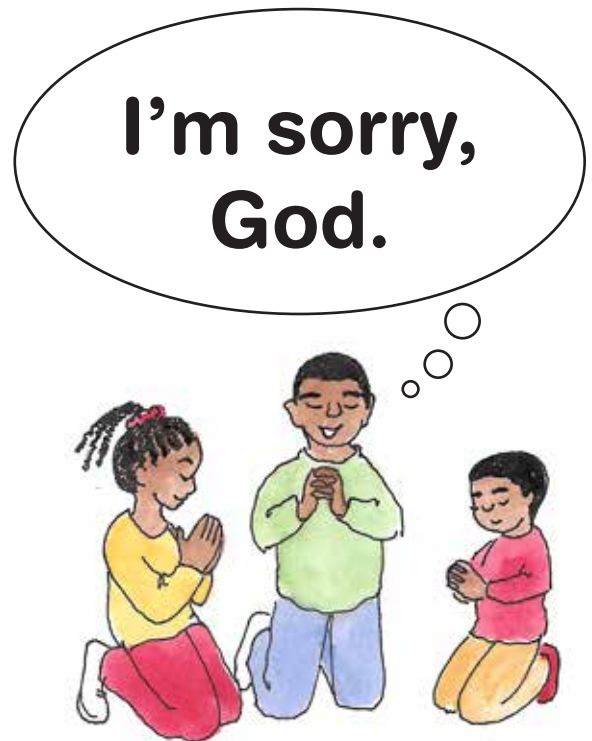
"You have trusted in your wickedness and have said, 'No one sees me.' Your wisdom and knowledge mislead you" (from Isaiah 46:10, NIV).
