


It was Family Day at church. Taylor's parents invited the whole family to come to church.

One of the people who accepted Jesus was Taylor's older cousin. The pastor shook his hand and prayed for him. The family was very happy.






BIBLE STORY

Paul told them that salvation would be for non-Jews, too. He knew they would listen and believe. Paul was there for two years, freely preaching about the kingdom of God and Jesus to all who came.




DEAR PARENTS
