






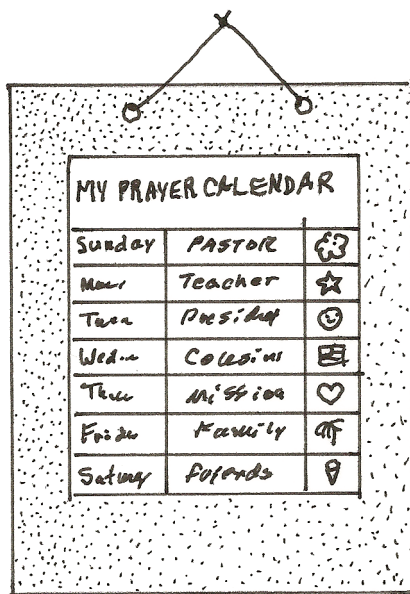


# MY PRAYER CALENDAR

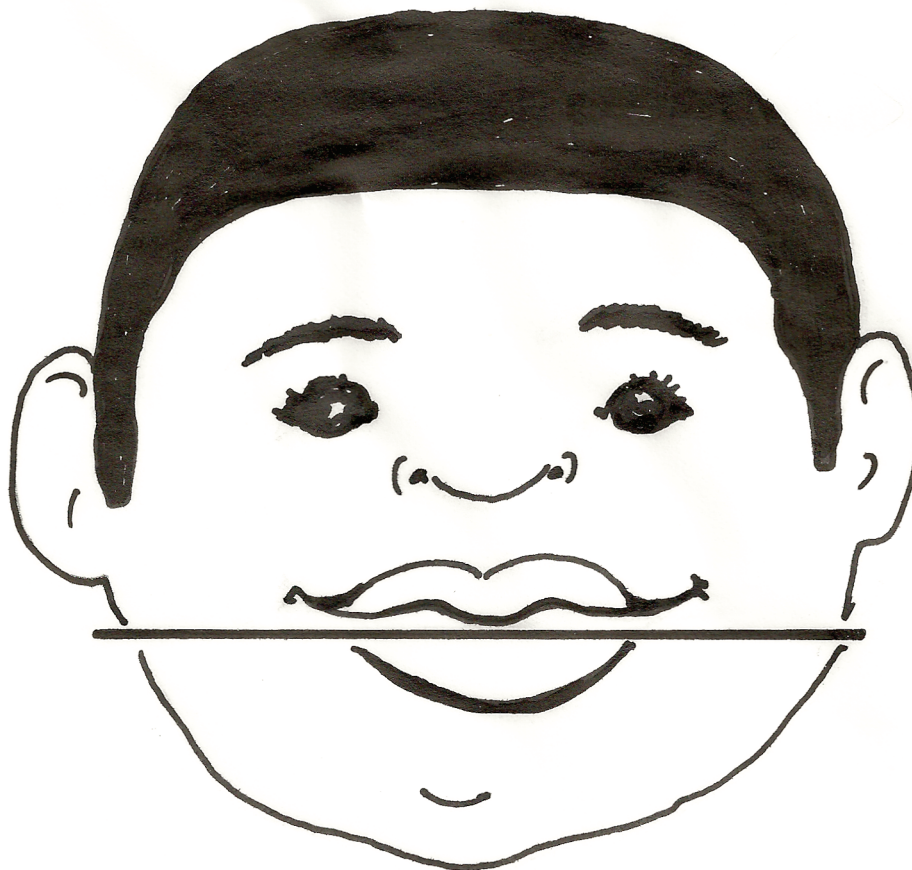

**Lesson 12:**

Color and cut out the prayer calendar from the activity page. Glue the calendar to a sheet of construction paper. Pray every day for the people listed. When the student prays, he or she may color the picture on that day.

**Enrichment suggestion:**

Students may write Bible verses about prayer around the edge of the paper. They may decorate the calendar with glitter.

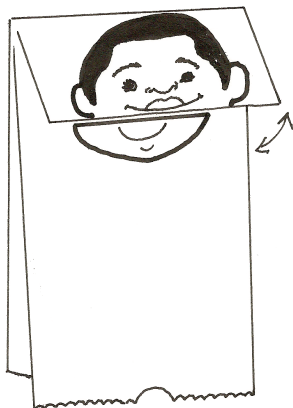


### THE A- B- Cs OF SALVATION

to take the punishment for your sins.

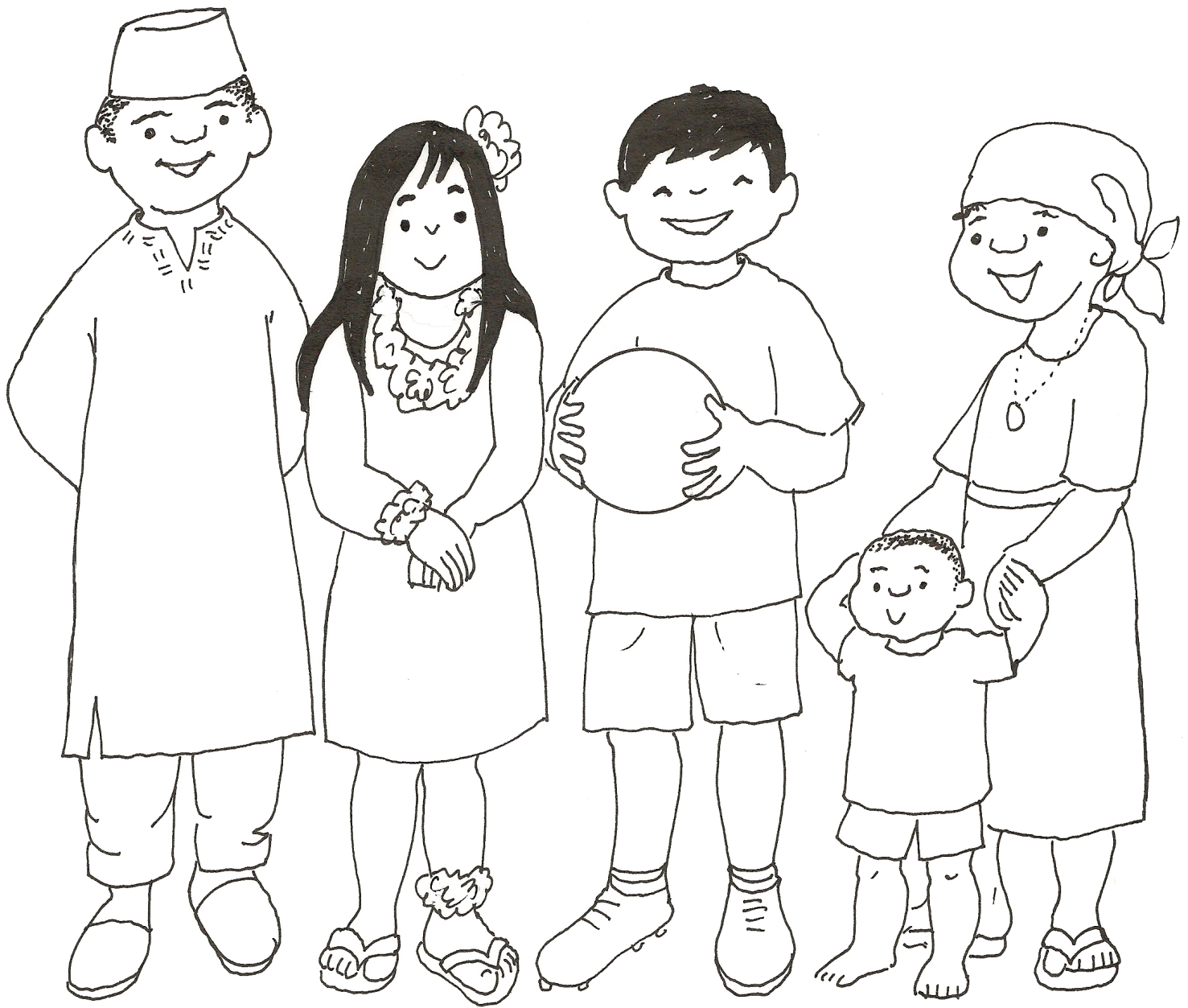
**C** - Call on Jesus to save you.

**Lesson 13:**

Make a hand puppet from a paper lunch bag. Color and cut out the face on the activity page. Cut the face apart on the dark line. Glue the top section of the face to the bottom of the paper bag. Glue the bottom section of the face to the bag right under the bottom fold. The child may put his hand inside the bag to make the mouth open and close to "speak."

**Enrichment suggestion:**

Children may glue the ABCs of salvation to the back of their bags or write them on the back of their bags. They may make the face "speak" those important words.

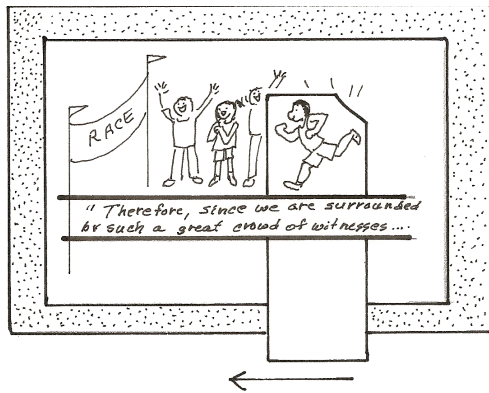
**Extra Craft:**

Color and cut out the picture of children on the activity page. Glue the picture near the top of a sheet of construction paper. Cut out the globe from the back cover. Glue the globe to the construction paper under the picture of the children. Punch two holes at the top of the page. Tie a 12" piece of yarn through the holes to hang.

**Enrichment suggestion:**

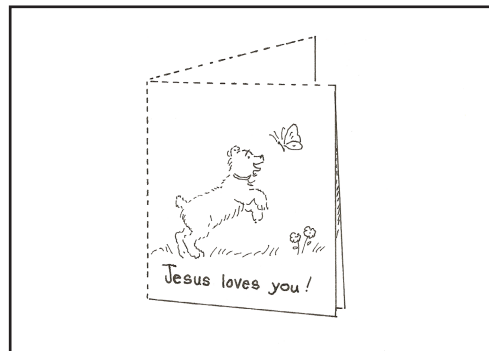
Students may decorate the banner with stickers. Talk with the students about the millions of people around the world who have never heard about Jesus. They need to hear about salvation, too.





### Lesson 3:

Color and cut out the activity page. Cut the two dark lines to make slits. The teacher may do this before class with a craft knife. Cut out the runner from the front cover. Slide the runner piece through the slits. Glue the activity page to a sheet of construction paper. Be careful to only put glue around the edge of the page. Slide the runner along the race track.

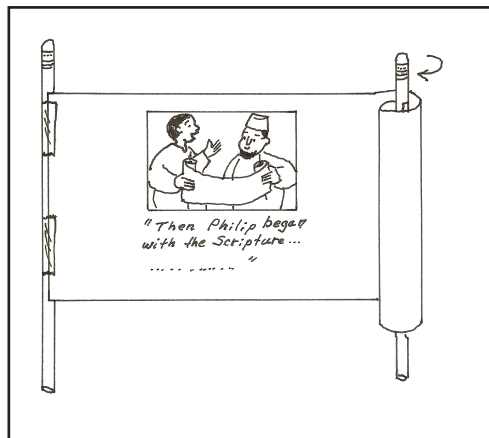


### Lesson 6:

Color the activity page. Fold the page on the dotted lines. The teacher may help young children write their names on the line. Encourage the children to give the card to someone they know.

### Enrichment Suggestion:

Be sure each student knows the ABCs of Salvation. They may practice telling a friend how to be forgiven of their sins. They may also write other Bible verses on the card.

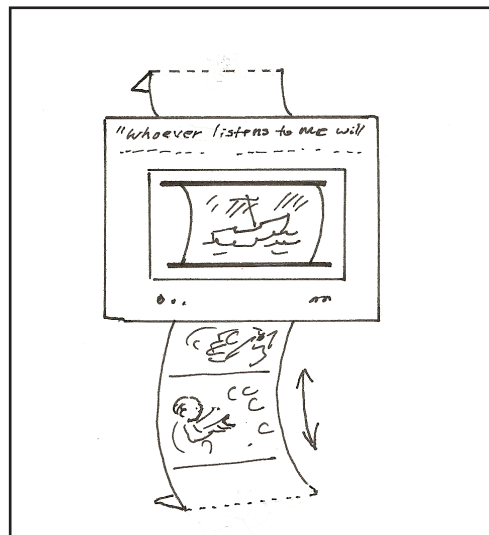


### Lesson 9:

Cut out the scroll on the dark lines. Cut out the picture of Philip and the Ethiopian man from the back cover. Glue the picture inside the gray lines. Tape a pencil on either end of the scroll. Roll the pencils toward the center to complete the scroll.

### Enrichment suggestion:

Students may write other favorite Bible verses in the scroll. They may also write the ABCs of Salvation inside the scroll.



### Lesson 11:

Color the activity page. Cut out the picture strip and the TV. Cut slits on the dark lines in the TV. The teacher may do this for the younger children before class. Thread the picture strip through the slits. Fold the ends of the picture strip to keep it from sliding out. The children may tell the story of Paul and the ship wreck by sliding the picture strip through the TV, one picture at a time.

### Enrichment suggestion:

Students may write a beginning title and an ending title for the "movie" in the spaces at the top and bottom of the strip.
